- 2) Judging will be to Y.A.A.S. Standards and approved Methods
- 3) All jars and Tanks to have sufficient airspace above the waterline
- 4) Classes 32 and 33 to consist of six fish; bred by the exhibitor and to be over Three months old. Date of spawning to be clearly marked on the tank.
- 5) Classes 28 and 29 must be true pairs
- 6) Whilst every care will be taken of the exhibits; no responsibility will be accepted for loss or damage.
- 7) No exhibit may be removed until judging is completed or without the Show secretary's permission.
- 8) All fish to be named as Judges and Standards recommend.
- 9) No fish may be photographed until after the class that they are in has been judged. n/p on tank - no photograph
- 10) When de-benching is announced all exits will be closed until it is established that No exhibits are missing
